#### • Regional Communications BSO Update: (A. Mize)

o Meeting held with DLE in regards to Ocean Zones

# • P25 Update: (S. Lowe & J. De Zayas)

- City of Hollywood migrating June 3<sup>rd</sup> to P25 system
- o Until 2<sup>nd</sup> touch, Zone 3 (Tacs) will be utilized to communicate with Hollywood
- o 2<sup>nd</sup> touch committee meeting kickoff meeting scheduled for tomorrow
- Revised paper template is attached to these minutes to include new talk groups and fail-soft frequencies
- o Final acceptance has not been completed on the P25 radio system project
- o Select PSIC talkgroups will be added to the dispatch consoles
- o Discussion to have FHP added to dispatch consoles
- o East Hollywood radio tower site project continues at a slow pace

#### • Fire Station Alerting: (S. Lowe)

- o 79 stations online, with two more scheduled for next week
- o Small uptick in power related issues has been seen
  - Ensure your UPS is working properly
- o USDD App is moving along, currently verifying info
- o Pilot testing will be coming soon before released for all agencies
- o Reminder Ztron will be decommissioned on September 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - Any station that is not going to be cut over to the USDD system by then, needs to make alternative arrangements to receive alerts
    - Keylite has a paging solution or Active 911 can be used
