Fire Academy/College Reports:

Coral Springs Regional Institute of Public Safety: Looking for instructors for all programs. Just had state test with 100% pass rate, second class going in the next week. Just posted technical rescue class on web, LFTI in Sept (refresher as well)

Hollywood Fire Academy / Barry Univ.: Barry will also provide refresher for LFTI if needed. 4th night class just started. Had 2 fail out of 39 in last state test. Started last night class for this year.

Broward Fire Academy: No Report STAR program to come back to BFA most likely a 5-6day program. Just sent out Rope Rescue announcement.

Department Reports:

Coral Springs: Looking to hire 3 possibly 7 in October. Worked on hosework at Margate's acquired structure. August will be 12-lead

Lauderhill: Finished 6 week recruit class, all passed, but 2 got COVID, will be having virtual badging ceremony for them. Four new rescues are in the state, waiting for finishing touches. Hoping for 5 new recruits in October. Surface water rescue scheduled for August.

Lighthouse Point: No Report

Plantation: Appreciate those that helped with Aerial class info. Hired 3 new Part time rescue personnel. Driver's class coming.

Pompano: No Report

Seminole Tribe: new recruit in training. Chief Hough has retired. New HazMat simulator trainer at Station 108. APX radio training

Pembroke Pines: pre-connect training, had 10 crews, enjoyed, learned a lot. 6 participated in the LT written exam 100% pass, practical August 11th. Battalion Chief Officer Development Program for promotion in September. Recruit class for 16 tentative to start August 16th. 8-10 week program.

Davie: Finished Hantevvy training. Working on saw work, built a garage door prop. Driver training, Driver Engineer written in August, practical in September.

Hollywood: Back to Basics next month. Preserving Fire Scene Evidence this week. HazMat and extrication in September. 7-8 recruits in October. Lt. Edwin Tapanes going to presenting Overhaul vs. Overkill

Fort Lauderdale: No Report

Margate: Thank you to all the departments that have come and played at the acquired structure. Tentatively have the building until December. Saws on rescue. September 1st those going to Coconut Creek find out, September 21st is Go live date. Surface water is scheduled for August.

Broward Sheriff's Office Fire Rescue: No Report

Miramar: Chief requested for geographical locations of students attending academies. 3 out of 4 new recruits made it. Captain's test for 4. Driver's training. 12 new hires for October. Portable standpipes in August, attended FFCA conference in Panama City, next year to be in Naples.

Oakland Park: Driver Engineer promotional test with Coral Springs. Just posted Rescue Supervisor position. New hiring process, 6 month review extended to 9 months. Looking to hire 1. Barry ride alongs with EMT/PM. 3 new hires passed. Working on first due size-ups. 3 with COVID.

Sunrise: 4 new hires coming in October, 8-week orientation. 14" Milwaukee saws going on trucks. Transferred to Firewolf foam. ACLS for the next 2 months.

Tamarac: introduced Lt Algeria assigned to training for a while. Surface water rescue for July training, trying to get dive team back. PALS/OB for next month. Active killer training with BSO and any other neighboring cities, focus is for command and above. 3-5 recruits in October. Asked question about Epic mics and Bluetooth vs. amplifier.

North Lauderdale: No Report

Department of Forestry: working with new hire. New hiring process next week. Tim's crew up for rotation could be sent to Montana.

Broward County Healthcare Coalition: No Report
