  - 1. Discussion of the 4 CERT goals: collaboration, communications, recruitment and retention at the last meeting; update provided

# E. **FIRE PREVENTION**: - Tommy Demopoulos for *Chief Lori Hastings, Broward Sherriff Office FR*

- 1. State Farm Grant Submission
  - a. BSO submitted grant for CPR devices to use throughout County
- 2. Inspectors Exam Discussion Update on requirements of Fire Inspector testing process
  - a. Bryan Parks and Matthew Decker from the School Board provided feedback on the testing process
  - b. After a long discussion held regarding the Fire Inspector Testing Process, a motion was requested by Chief Downey recommending FCABC support to allow people to take the FI test 3 times with ADA compliance as follows:
    - After 3 unsuccessful attempts
    - A remedial class developed by the Fire Prevention Group will be established
    - After the remedial class is completed; candidates will be allowed to take the test 3 more times

**Motion** was made by Chief Krivjanik and seconded by Chief Lucas to support the New Fire Inspector Testing Process. Motion passed with all attendees in favor

- Bryan Parks said the feedback/recommendation will be brought to the Board for discussion of the motion. Item will probably be added to next month's Board of Rules and Appeals meeting
- 3. Proposed amendment was sent to Broward County Fire Code Committee for AED and Stop the Bleed Kits to be in certain facilities
- 4. Chief Demopoulos provided an update and requested support from the FCABC through the Florida Building Code to amend and change code for Elevator size to accommodate a stretcher from 76" to 84" in new constructions
- 5. Matt Decker from the School Board talked about school BDA, radios signal / strength in school buildings
  - a. A letter of support to Broward County School for fire safety inspectors to have access to the County Regional Public Safety Communication frequencies
  - b. Fire safety inspectors will conduct frequency testing to see if school buildings have deficiencies that should be further explored
  - c. Discussion held with feedback from Chief Levy
  - d. Chief Krivjanik will contact Chief Levy to redact a letter of support on behalf of FCABC

### F. HAZMAT/SPECIAL OPS - Chief Bowers for Chief Nugent, Broward Sherriff Office FR

- 1. Coordination of a 160 class is underway with funding from LEPC
- 2. Update on the Hazmat Instructors Conference to be held in Florida in November
