 - \circ 5 year anniversary of the FSA equipment Looking to lifecycle the equipment in 2024-25.
 - FSA Dashboard at the dispatchers level has been tabled until system can be made independent of CAD
 - P25 upgrading the talk group logging solution (May of 2024)
 - ARL went live on Dec 12- working on some deliverables before close out
 - Showcased the latest dispatch console to a core group in Dispatch-life cycling in the next 2 years
 - Upgrade of the radio systems router per contractual lifecycle
